

ACCEPTABLE ENGLISH TESTS

All persons whose primary language is not English are required to successfully complete an English language proficiency test. The SRNA accepts the following tests as meeting this requirement for eligibility for registration in Saskatchewan.

'Primary language shall be defined as the language you learned at home in childhood or it is the language which you identify as knowing best and being most comfortable with and is the language primarily used for reading, writing, listening, and speaking.'

- The scores listed below are the **minimum** scores we accept.
- Combined scores from different tests are not acceptable.
- If your test results become more than two years old **at any time during the application process or prior to registration**, you will be required to provide updated test results. Acceptable English language test results **must remain** current throughout the application and exam process **until RN licensure has been obtained**.
