## Mandate

The Legislation and Bylaws Committee is created in the Bylaws and shall assist Council in ensuring appropriate legislation and bylaws.

## Composition, Tenure and Quorum

- 1. **Composition** The committee is appointed by Council and is composed of the following:
- Chair selected from the Committee.
- At least four members with equal representation from the profession and public representatives.
- Of the Committee members there should be at least one current Council member and one former Council member.
- 2. **Tenure** –Members of this committee shall be appointed for a 3-year term, renewable for one additional term. Terms of office shall be staggered to provide for continuity.
- 3. **Quorum** Two members of the committee constitute quorum.

## Authority

The Committee has the authority to assist Council in its work related to potential changes to legislation affecting nursing and *The Registered Nurses Act, 1988*. The Committee has the authority to assist Council in its work related to drafting revisions to Bylaws.

Duties and Responsibilities

The Committee is responsible to produce:

- 1. Background information, issues and to identify options for Council's consideration regarding potential changes to legislation affecting nursing;
- 2. Background information, issues and to identify options for Council's consideration regarding potential changes to *The Registered Nurses Act, 1988*; and



3. Upon direction from the Council, to draft revisions for *The Registered Nurses Act, 1988* and Bylaws.

Meetings Meetings will be called as needed, by the Chair.

Review Every three years by Governance & Human Resources Committee
